Topic: "Nova Scotia's Rejection of Confederation: Presbyterian Dissent and a Tax Revolt"

Daniel Samson is Associate Professor and Chair of the History Department at Brock University. He teaches courses on colonial Canada, and North American environmental history, rural history, and the history of food.
