Topic: Does the World need more Canada?

Speaker's Bio:

**Christopher Johnston** *Global Affairs Canada* 



Chris Johnston is a Canadian diplomat, aid worker and seasoned researcher, analyst and international development project manager. He currently manages the Canadian development assistance program in

Pakistan. He returned to Canada in 2014 following diplomatic postings with the Government of Canada in Afghanistan and in South Africa where he oversaw Canada's development cooperation programs and policy engagement in a number of countries in Southern Africa. During a leave of absence in 2014-15, Chris was Senior Manager for Research and Policy with The MasterCard Foundation in Toronto.

With over 20 years of experience in the international development sector, Chris has worked in management positions with several organizations including the Canadian International Development Agency, the Aga Khan Foundation, the National Judicial Institute and the Canadian Co-operative Association. He has a wide background in strategic policy, development research, technical cooperation, program design, and Monitoring & Evaluation, and has worked in over 30 countries. Chris has managed a range of programs covering rural poverty reduction, private sector development, aid architecture, microfinance/microinsurance, community development, micro- and small-enterprise, gender and economic empowerment, youth employment, legal-judicial reform, health and education, capacity development, leadership, knowledge management and governance.

Chris is an alumnus of Brock University (1988). He holds a Master's Degree in International Development Studies from St. Mary's / Dalhousie University. He has served on the boards of the Canadian Cooperative Association (CCA) the Afghanistan Research and Evaluation Unit (AREU) and the Philippines Development Assistance Program (PDAP, an NGO coalition).
